Below is my summary:

Major features which will be a part of the Readiness Tracker phase II deployment scheduled for January 25, 2010 are described below.

Readiness Tracker has expanded beyond DOD (Department of Defense) coordination of MRAP (Mine Resistant Ambush Protected) emergency buys and will now allow the addition of projects based on other weapon system groups. The security has been enhanced to segment DOD and write access control to the persons responsible for a weapon system group. Design and architecture have been modified to meet the performance needs of those forward deployed in support of OEF (Operation Enduring Freedom) and OIF (Operations Iraqi Freedom) and they will see a significant performance speed boost throughout. Key metrics are now captured to allow individual emergency buy history reporting and project level reports that will show the average time it takes
